

ARRIVING IN FINLAND

Visa requirements:

There are some countries whose nationals need a visa to travel to Finland. A Visa can be obtained from the nearest Finnish Embassy or Consulate.

By plane:

Helsinki-Vantaa airport is situated 20 km north of Helsinki, about 25 km north-east of Kauniainen. There are several options how to travel from the airport to the Workers' Academy which is situated in Kauniainen (Työväen Akatemia, Vanha Turuntie 14, 02700 Kauniainen).

1. **Taxi** takes you from door to door in 30 minutes. The cost for one person is about 35 €, for four persons about 85 €.
2. **Yellow Line Airport Taxi** takes you straight from the airport to Workers' Academy (27 € per person)
3. **Finnair Bus – Train – Taxi:** You can also take a Finnair bus from the airport to the Helsinki city Railway station (5 €, about 30 minutes). Change to the local train from Helsinki to Karjaa or Kirkkonummi. L, E, S and U -trains stop at Kauniainen (3 €, about 30 minutes). And then a taxi from the Kauniainen railway station to the Workers' Academy (max 10 €).

By boat:

Boats from Sweden, Estonia and Germany arrive in various passenger terminals in Helsinki. You can take a tram or a bus from harbor to the city center, to Railway Station (2 €). Then take a local train (L, E, S or U) from Helsinki to Kauniainen (3 €) and taxi from Kauniainen railway station to the Workers' Academy.
