INVITATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Bergama Congress and PMC, these co-events will be referred to as The Congress.

The Congress will be organized mainly for psychodrama trainees, trainers and PD practitioners. While PMC part is only for psychodramatists and psychodrama trainees, Group Psychotherapies Congress part is open to medical doctors, mental health professionals, psychotherapists from other modalities as well.

Time

The Congress begins on May 30, Wednesday at 10:00 and ends on June 2, Saturday at 19:30.

For those who will not participate in Annual Meeting, we recommend that you make your flight reservations to arrive on May 29 and depart on June 3, 2007. Those who have already arrived for the FEPTO Annual Meeting in Alacati will be taken to Pergamon by bus or shuttle on May 29.

Visa Requirements

A valid passport is required for all international visitors. There is no entry or departure tax. The countries whose citizens are required to have a visa without an invitation are: Austria, Belgium, Hungary, Italy, Netherlands, Portugal, Norway, Romania, the Russian Federation, Spain, and United Kingdom. The countries whose citizens are exempt from visa are: Bulgaria, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Israel, Sweden, and Switzerland. The invitation letter will be written by FEPTO Local coordinator when it's asked for. The visa can be obtained from the nearest Turkish Embassy or consulate.

The Congress Venue

110 km from Izmir, the Congress venue is Pergamon Aesclepion.

The Accommodation Venue

24 km from Aesklepion, the main accommodation venue is Mysia Hotel in Dikili. Club Antur, Ummetoglu Hotel and pensions in the neighbourhood may be used for accommodations also. Dalya Tur will help to the participants who come from abroad to find accommodations. Participants from Turkey have to find their accommodations themselves –except Mysia Hotel.

Transport between congress location and accommodations: Will be out of fee by the facilities which Pergamon Municipality will provide.

Weather Condition: At May, Pergamon has 27 -32° C air, and 22 - 24° C sea heat. Generally weather condition is suitable to take a sea bath. To protect sun burn during the lectures at the Aesclepion amphitheater it is suggested to bring umbrella, cap, sunglasses etc. Clothes for spring or summer may be sufficient in day time but at nights wool jackets may be necessary.

Language of Congress: The language of the Congress is bilingual in principle. In group workshops Jutta Fürst, Yaacov Naor, Eva Fahlström- Strömberg (supervision) will work only in English (**these 3 groups are the PMC groups**); Grete Leutz, Judith Teszáry, Jorge Burmeister & Natacha Navarro in parallel group with Gábor & Barbara Pintèr, Maurizio Gasseau, Inci Doğaner, Arşaluys Kayir will work in English/Turkish (**trainers, trainees of FEPTO Member Institutes are also welcomed in these 7 groups**); Ali Babaoglu, Bahar Gökler, Emre Kapkın will work only in Turkish.

Congress Registration is obligatory for group workshop registration. The registration date will be taken into consideration in forming groups.
