We will have three and possibly four European facilitators;

Judith Teszáry – President of FEPTO. Judith lives in Sweden and regularly trains psychodramatists in both Sweden and Hungary. In addition she has travelled extensively presenting psychodrama and has a regular input at the annual psychotherapy conference in Bergama, Turkey.

Jutta Fürst – Teaches Psychodrama at; The Institute of Communication in the Professional Field and Psychotherapy of the University of Innsbruck.

Monica Westberg – Is the founder and main trainer of the Psychodrama Academy in Sweden.

All are founder members of FEPTO.

The conference will offer workshop groups at 2 levels;

An experiential workshop for trainees and practitioners of psychodrama seeking more knowledge. This group is in the ethos of the Beacon model. The original Moreno Institute where all categories of participants worked together.

A second group for Trainers and Supervisors of psychodrama where they will explore different ways to approach supervision of trainees. A record will be made of this group for further research.

This event will credit participants with 15 hours of Training/CPD

The venue can be accessed easily from Edinburgh, Glasgow International and Prestwick airports. It is situated behind Charing Cross Station and adjacent to The Kings Theatre.

Glasgow, European city of culture in 1990, will host the Commonwealth Games in 2014. It has many fine buildings both old and new and parks and museums within easy reach of the town centre. Buchanan Street with Princes Square and The Buchanan Galleries offers an opportunity of shopping to satisfy the most dedicated shoppers and then why not dine out?
